2022 KEY DATES

January 03-14 | ADVISORS can begin registering student 20-page written teams – must identify team captain – instructions will be sent via advisor email on January 6.

January 14 | All participant teams registered by 5:00 p.m. PST

January 18 | Team Captains can begin uploading 20-page written projects

January 21 | 20-page written events due by 12:00 p.m. PST (submit PDF online - don't wait until the last minute!)

January 28 | 20-page qualifiers announced and sent to advisors

February 07 | ADVISORS must have registered a proctor in SCDC registration

February 09-11 | SCDC testing (times below)

February 14-17 | 10-page written events due by 5:00 p.m. PST (submit PDF online - don't wait until the last minute!)

March 03-05 | State Career Development Conference
