This form must be completed by the lead advisor and turned into angela@wadeca.org by February 25, 2022, with a list of the school's conference delegates and chaperones. On the list, please have delegates and chaperones initial next to their name, to confirm they are vaccinated.

An additional online form will need to be completed individually by chaperones and delegates who will be submitting a negative COVID test (taken no earlier than noon March 2, 2022). If Form is not completed, delegates will be disqualified from competition. Upload negative test by March 3 at noon. The FDA-approved PCR test must be conducted by a testing agent, including a school nurse, laboratory, health care provider, or pharmacy. Additionally, ANY test administered by a school nurse is acceptable. OVER-THE-COUNTER OR AT-HOME COVID-TEST RESULTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. As per King County guidelines, medical and religious vaccine exemptions are not accepted in place of a negative COVID test.

These forms are the only verification needed throughout the conference as long as the delegate is wearing their conference name badge with vaccine verification sticker (provided by Washington DECA).

Note: King County requires COVID vaccination or a negative test, within 72 hours (from the end of the conference), to participate in events and access restaurants and other businesses. State Career Development Conference delegates must wear name tags at all times with vaccine verification sticker to access conference activities.
