Do's and Don't's of Member Interaction (online, in person, etc)



DO'S!

- Introduce yourself in a positive manner
- Act with kindness and compassion
- When conversing with a member, learn about them.
 Getting to know and remembering details about a potential or current member can make them feel special and develop a deeper connection with your chapter

These DO'S are very important! As a leader of your chapter, you want to leave members with a positive experience, whether the interaction be online or in person!






DONT'S

- Don't just keep to yourself reach out to members! They are likely feeling nervous to initiate interactions as well
- Don't be dismissive or rude to any members
- Don't act in a way that would reflect poorly on yourself or your chapter - your members are looking to you!


It is important that you avoid doing all of these DONT'S!

Using Appropriate Body Language



Appropriate body language can consist of...

- Facing towards the person you are speaking too
- Making good eye contact
- Nodding or simply showing you are actively listening





Make Sure to Speak Clearly!

This can involve...

- Speaking slowly
- Speaking simply
- Using appropriate words
- Ask for clarification of needed
- Body language has a role to play while communicating!
